NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog/each trial and \$18.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in the **same trial**. (Includes \$3.00 event service fee per entry and \$.50 AKC recording fee on first entry).

RALLY: \$25.00 first entry of each dog/each trial, and \$18.00 for second entry of the same dog in the **same trial**. (Includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee per entry)

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT SIGNATURE AND FEES. Entries not on an official entry form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules as on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are **UNACCEPTABLE**.

MAIL ENTRIES AND FEES TO: Linda Lemmer, 1311 Williams St, Saginaw, MI 48602-2443. Entries sent overnight or express mail or other similar services should be designated "**NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**".

MAKE CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: Tri Cities Dog Training Club (TCBTC). **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST MAKE FEES PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS.** Returned checks will not be considered as valid entries. **\$25.00 NSF fee will be charged!** **POST-DATED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made. However, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms or whoever may make such errors. And no entry fee will be refunded in the event such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing day.

ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE along with identification, a judging program and directions to the trial site. Should acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, notify the trial secretary at 989-791-4743 or email – tertvuk@msn.com.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, is disqualified, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, or other circumstances beyond the control of the management, and it is not possible to open or complete the trial **NO** refund shall be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON. No refund for bitches in season.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING. **NO** practicing will be allowed in the rings at any time. Dogs that are not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

THE MANAGEMENT WILL EXERCISE EVERY PRECAUTION FOR THE SAFETY OF DOGS exhibited, but it is understood that neither the Officers, Club nor Midland Country Fairgrounds will be responsible for the loss of, nor damage, or any other damage caused by or to any dog from **ANY CAUSE**.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

FROM NORTHEAST, EAST, & SOUTHEAST: I-75 to US-10 west at Bay City to Eastman exit. Turn right on Eastman to Fairgrounds entrance on the left (between Fairview Plaza and Applebee's)

FROM NORTHWEST: US-10 to Eastman exit. Left at intersection at end of exit ramp, under US-10 to Fairgrounds entrance on left (between Fairview Plaza and Applebee's)

FROM SOUTHWEST: US-27 to M-20 east at Mt Pleasant to B.R. US-10 west to US-10 underpass to Fairgrounds entrance on left (between Fairview Plaza and Applebee's)
